Mindshift

Our goal is to write a breakthrough prayer using the “welcome, care, serve, and share” language to be shared in the September 10 worship service, which means a September 5 writing deadline. By October 1, 80% of the groups gathering at Haygood on a regular basis (weekly, monthly) will be praying the prayer. We are creating this new breakthrough prayer so that the church body is aligned and praying as one. The prayer will be reassessed annually by the Leadership Board.

Community

Our goal is to partner with the city of Virginia Beach, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct of the police and other churches so that the community will feel safe and build trust. We want 10% of our average worshipping attendance (180 as of retreat date) to participate in 100% of the programs offered by the city and 3<sup>rd</sup> precinct throughout the year. We desire this so that we can welcome, care serve and share God’s kingdom in our community.

Discipleship

By February 29, provide small group opportunities for those who are interested in intentional faith development so that they can define and describe their strengths in order to be fully engaged in welcoming, caring, serving, and sharing the kingdom of God in their lives of discipleship.
